Action:

Tom will supply a brief explanation of each charity, and you will be able to vote for one charity per person.

b) The committee agreed that £10 per ticket was a reasonable cost and would cover tea and cake in the interval. The Lifford Hall holds 180 people, that includes the number of our choir off the stage. Once we have a commitment of the numbers of choir participants, we will know how many tickets to sell minus 25. These are reserved for the partners of the Welsh Choir, they will be paying for their tickets.

Action:

Annie is arranging for the tickets to be printed Dave has agreed to sell the tickets at choir for £10 each, cash only. Any surplus tickets will be sold elsewhere in the village.

Dress code:

We discussed and agreed a dress code for the concert and suggest that the women wear all black. Either a dress or separates and we will be supplying a red rose to pin on the top. The men will also be in black trousers and shirt and will be wearing a white bow tie. For information, the Welsh choir will be wearing black trousers, white shirt and red bow tie.

Action:

Siân will supply the roses and the bow ties.

d) Refreshments:

Prior to the concert we will supply sandwiches and cakes for the choirs.

There is no drinks licence for the evening, and it will be impractical for people to bring their own as we will not have tables but rows of seats. So, we agreed there would be tea and coffees in the interval and cakes. This will be included in the price of the ticket.
